
GRAHAM JONES COOKIE POLICY AND TERMS AND CONDITIONS

BACKGROUND:

This website www.grahamjones.co.uk (“the site”) uses Cookies and similar technologies in order to distinguish you from other users. By using Cookies, this site is able to provide you with a better experience and to improve the site by better understanding how you use it. 1. Definitions and Interpretation

1.1 In this Cookie Policy, unless the context otherwise requires, the following expressions have the following meanings:

“Cookie”	means a small file placed on your computer or device by the site when you visit certain parts of the site and/or when you use certain features of the site;
“Cookie Law”	means the relevant parts of the Privacy and Electronic Communications (EC Directive) Regulations 2003 and of EU Regulation 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”);
“personal data”	means any and all data that relates to an identifiable person who can be directly or indirectly identified from that data, as defined by the Data Protection Act 1998 and the EU Regulation 2016/679 General Data Protection Regulation (“GDPR”);

2. Information About us

3. How Does the site use Cookies?

- 3.1 The site may place and access certain first-party Cookies on your computer or device. First-party Cookies are those placed directly by this site and are used only by me. I use Cookies to facilitate and improve your experience of the site and to provide and improve my products and services. I have carefully chosen

these Cookies and have taken steps to ensure that your privacy and personal data is protected and respected at all times.

3.2 By using the site, you may also receive certain third-party Cookies on your computer or device. Third-party Cookies are those placed by websites, services, and/or parties other than me. Third-party Cookies may be in use from time to time on the site for the purposes of analytics, advertising, marketing, social media, service delivery. For more details, please refer to section 4 below.

3.3 All Cookies used by and on the site are used in accordance with current Cookie Law. This site may use some or all of the following types of Cookie:

3.3.1 Strictly Necessary Cookies

A Cookie falls into this category if it is essential to the operation of the site, supporting functions such as logging in, your shopping basket, and payment transactions.

3.3.2 Analytics Cookies

It is important for me to understand how you use the site, for example, how efficiently you are able to navigate around it, and what features you use. Analytics Cookies enable me to gather this information, helping me to improve the site and your experience of it.

3.3.3 Functionality Cookies

Functionality Cookies enable me to provide additional functions to you on the site such as personalisation and remembering your saved preferences. Some functionality Cookies may also be strictly necessary Cookies, but not all necessarily fall into that category.

3.3.4 Targeting Cookies

It is important for me to know when and how often you visit the site, and which parts of it you have used (including which pages you have visited and which links you have visited). As with analytics Cookies, this information helps me to better understand you and, in turn, to make the site and advertising more relevant to your interests.

3.3.5 Third-Party Cookies

Third-party Cookies are not placed by me; instead, they are placed by third-parties that provide services to me and/or to you. Third-party Cookies may be used by advertising services to serve up tailored advertising to you on the site, or by third parties providing analytics services to me (these Cookies will work in the same way as analytics Cookies described above).

3.3.6 Persistent Cookies

Any of the above types of Cookie may be a persistent Cookie. Persistent Cookies are those which remain on your computer or device for a predetermined period and are activated each time you visit the site.

3.3.7 Session Cookies

Any of the above types of Cookie may be a session Cookie. Session Cookies are temporary and only remain on your computer or device from the point at which you visit the site until you close your browser. Session Cookies are deleted when you close your browser.
